Treatment of benign skin lesions - with Liquid Nitrogen and NO local anesthesia	\$30.00 the first lesion plus \$10.00 for each subsequent lesion	On any area of the body
Treatment of benign skin lesions- with electro fulguration and curetting and thus requiring local anesthesia:	\$100.00 for the first lesion and \$75.00 for each subsequent lesion.	On face and neck
	\$75.00	On any other area of the body
Excision of confirmed benign moles (Always under local anesthesia):	\$100.00 for the first mole and \$75.00 for each subsequent one.	On the face and neck. Shaved excision. No sutures
	\$150.00 for the first mole and \$125.00 for each subsequent one.	On the face and neck. Block excision with cosmetic repair
Excision of Skin tags	\$50.00 for the first one and \$30.00 for each subsequent one.	On any other area of the body <u>without</u> local anesthesia

	\$75.00 for the first one and \$50.00 for each subsequent one.	On any other area of the body <u>with</u> local anesthesia
Cosmetic Procedures not Covered by OHIP		
Removal of Warts	\$30.00 the first lesion plus \$10.00 for each subsequent lesion.	On any area of the body (aside from plantar and genital warts)
